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INTRODUCTION

Along with your QX-10, you received the $\underline{CP}+\underline{User}$ \underline{Guide} and the $\underline{CP/M}$ \underline{Primer} . These manuals provide most - but not all - of the information you will need as you run CP/M-80 on your QX-10. In other words, there are some gaps between what the \underline{Guide} and the \underline{Primer} tell you, and what you need to know to use $\underline{CP/M-80}$ with ease.

This manual fills in the gaps, elaborating on the specifics of CP/M-80 in relation to the QX-10. It assumes that you are already familiar with the contents of the QX-10 Operations Manual, and are now ready to put your QX-10 to work.

- Chapter 1 introduces CP+, the easy way to run CP/M-80. In this section, you'll learn to use CP+ in DEMO mode in the beginning, and to switch to FULLY-FUNCTIONAL mode later on.
- Chapter 2 offers detailed descriptions of CP/M-80 system characteristics and QX-10 configurations supported by CP/M-80.
- Chapter 3 presents the special QX-10 utilities, COPYDISK, and SETUP.
- The Appendixes provide valuable additional information about the QX-10 under CP/M-80.
